<sup>1</sup> A student exempted from ENGL 100 must substitute a three-credit unrestricted elective, which should be selected in consultation with the student's advisor.

<sup>2</sup> SUNY GEN ED Mathematics Elective: Select in consultation with the student's advisor, in accord with the student's transfer plans. MATH 200 is recommended for those intending to transfer into a 4-year Psychology program.

<sup>3</sup> Social Science Electives: Select in consultation with the student's advisor. Place students in program courses as soon as possible.

<sup>4</sup> Unrestricted Electives: Select in consultation with the student's advisor. No more than 3 FITN credits may be used.

<sup>5</sup> Students with an interest in transferring for psychology should take two sequential biology courses. The recommended sequence is BIOL 102 & BIOL 101, in that order, but the appropriate courses should be selected in consultation with the student's advisor.

<sup>6</sup> Students are encouraged to use their third and fourth semester Unrestricted Electives to take a two-semester language series.

<sup>7</sup> Students with an interest in transferring for psychology should take PSYC 290. All other students should take ANTH/SOCI/HSTY 290.

<sup>8</sup> Oral Communication Course: Select in consultation with the student's academic advisor, in accord with the student's transfer plans.

<sup>9</sup> SUNY GEN ED Restricted Elective: Select from U.S. History and Civic Engagement OR World History and Global Awareness.
